### **Welcome/Introductions**

The meeting was called to order at 5:55 p.m. on June 12, 2014 by RCAC President Matt Rhodes. Introductions were made of all present. The mission, vision, and ground rules were read. Minutes for May meeting were approved.

### **Open Mic – Community-Related**

### **Open Mic – Plant-Related**

The Louisville Emergency Management Agency will hold a Safety Fair from 11 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Saturday, July 12, at Mount Vernon Missionary Baptist Church at 3640 Cane Run Road. The RCAC will participate and needs volunteers. Jana Zigrye circulated a volunteer sign-up sheet.

Rich Robinson shared that American Synthetic made a 911 call on Monday morning, June 9, for a leak of butadiene. The leak occurred due to a ball valve failure during a pressure gauge change. Approximately 48 pounds of butadiene were released. The reportable quantity for butadiene is 10 pounds. An exposed worker was seen by a company doctor and released. The investigation to determine the root cause is on-going.

Rich Robinson introduced Guillaume Coiraton, ASRC's plant manager as of July 1. Brad Karas, the former plant manager, has taken a position with the company in Asia.

Alex Novak, MSD, gave an update on construction for MSD's new Southwest Pump Station. Expect increased activity on the project soon near 41<sup>st</sup> Street and Bells Lane. Construction vehicles may enter from Campground Road or Bells Lane.

Rick Poynter introduced Corinne Greenberg, Carbide's new environmental manager. Corinne will be Carbide's plant representative for RCAC. Rick will focus on Safety and Security issues for the plant.

Matt Rhodes welcomed back Peggy Bolton, who missed the last couple of meetings due to injury.
