## **LG&E Update – Paddy’s Run Coal Plant Demolition**

Demolition of LG&E’s Paddy’s Run plant at the end of Bell’s Lane began in mid-March 2016. The demolition is being handled by two contractors, one for demolition and another for asbestos abatement. Seventy-five employees are working on the demolition project. The project schedule is 6:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Monday – Saturday.

Demolition plans are to return the land to grade. The project is scheduled to be complete in the fourth quarter of 2017.
