Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by RCAC President Brenda Kelting. Introductions were made by all present. The RCAC mission, vision, and ground rules were read. The February meeting minutes were approved.

Open Mic – Community-Related

Matt Rhodes informed the group that Kentucky has seen its first ZIKA virus case and it is in Louisville. The infected person, returning from a mission trip in Central America, is no longer infectious. The city will begin pretreatment for mosquitos in April.

Tim Osburn, Louisville Emergency Management Agency, gave the group an update on the active shooter drill held at Slugger Field on March 9. He reported that the drill helped identify opportunities for improvement allowed them to practice working together with other responding agencies.

Open Mic – Plant-Related

Corinne Greenberg announced that Air and Waste Management will hold a one day Environmental Practitioners' Workshop on April 20 in Florence, Ky.

Lori Carson reported on Zeon's community service activities, including donating twenty-two monitors to Wilkerson Elementary, cookies to Kosair, and eighty pounds of food to the Shively Area Ministries.

Guillaume Coiraton reported that American Synthetic made a 911 call due to a release that occurred in the process upon startup. The release was below the reportable quantity, so the call was deemed precautionary.

Neighborhood Cleanup Preparations & Sign Ups – Jana Zigrye

The RCAC will hold its annual neighborhood cleanup on Thursday, April 14, before the monthly RCAC meeting. There are three zones that will be targeted by RCAC for the cleanup. As in past years, Hexion employees will pick up along Campground Road and Zeon will collect and dispose of the trash.
